ONE Direction's Harry Styles has been buying dark modern art — including a skull.

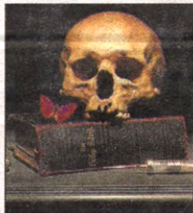
He snapped up the cast bone bonce — perched on a Bible beside a hypodermic — along with a statue of Jesus wearing **BOXING GLOVES**.
